

Job Supports on Goodwill's United Way Grant

What is it: Goodwill Industries received a grant from United Way to provide job-coaching supports for transitioned age youth ages 18-28 at employment. Job coaching supports assist with employment success and retention. Can be off or on site, depending on youth's needs.

Who is Eligible: Focus on youth age ranges roughly 18-28. Serving those who are wait list for MaineCare(MC) services long term supports (LTS) or ineligible for other LTS job supports funding. MC wait list runs about up to 2 years out.

How it works: Once placed in employment Goodwill's United Way grant dollars picks up job coaching funding. Goodwill can also assist with placing into employment if needed.

How do I apply: No wait list or application process needed. Connect with Caroline Rodrick for more details on how to get your youth involved. Goodwill prepares employment plan and provides job-coaching supports as needed to maintain successful employment.
