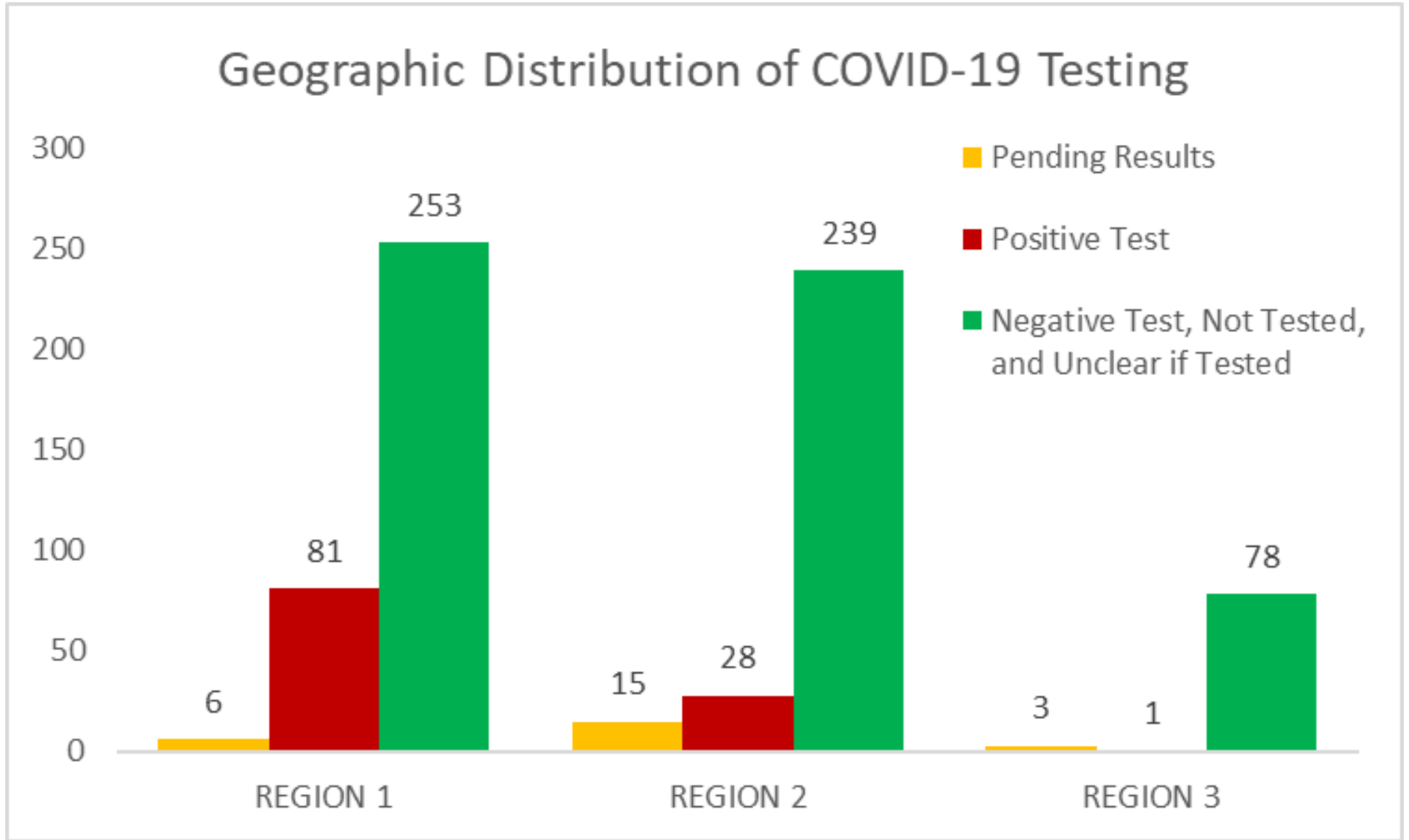

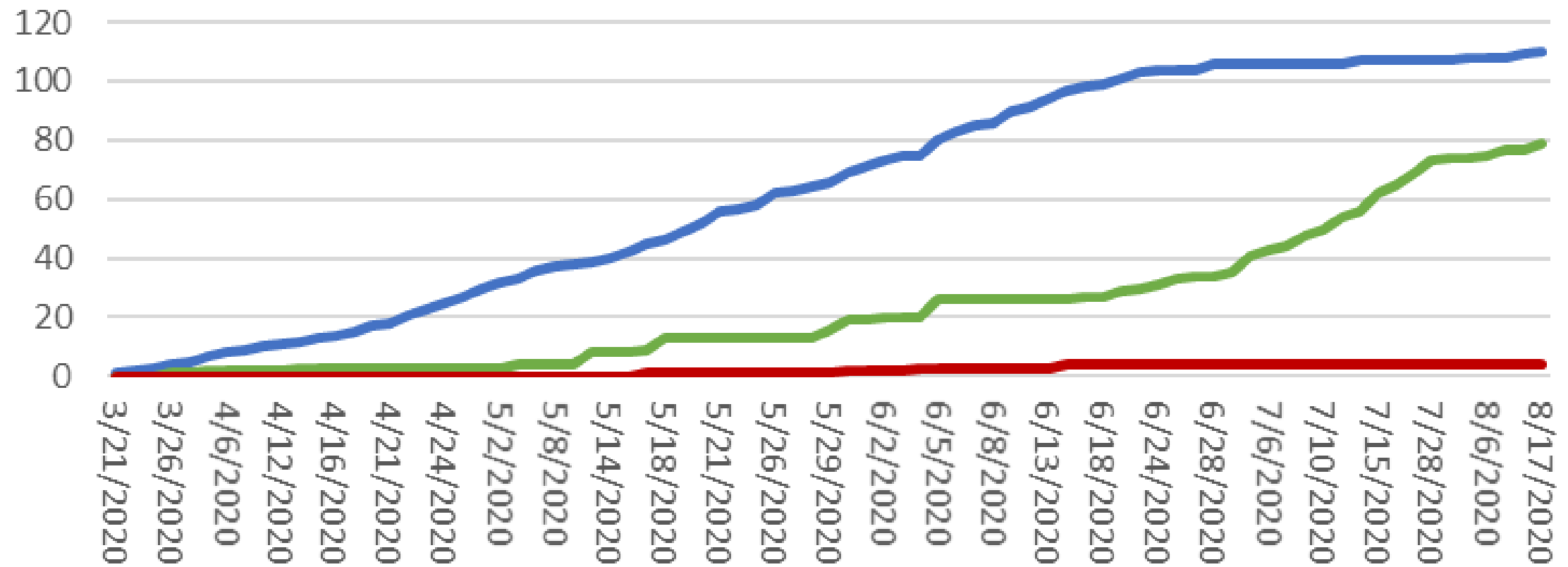

Client COVID-19 Case Outcomes Over Time

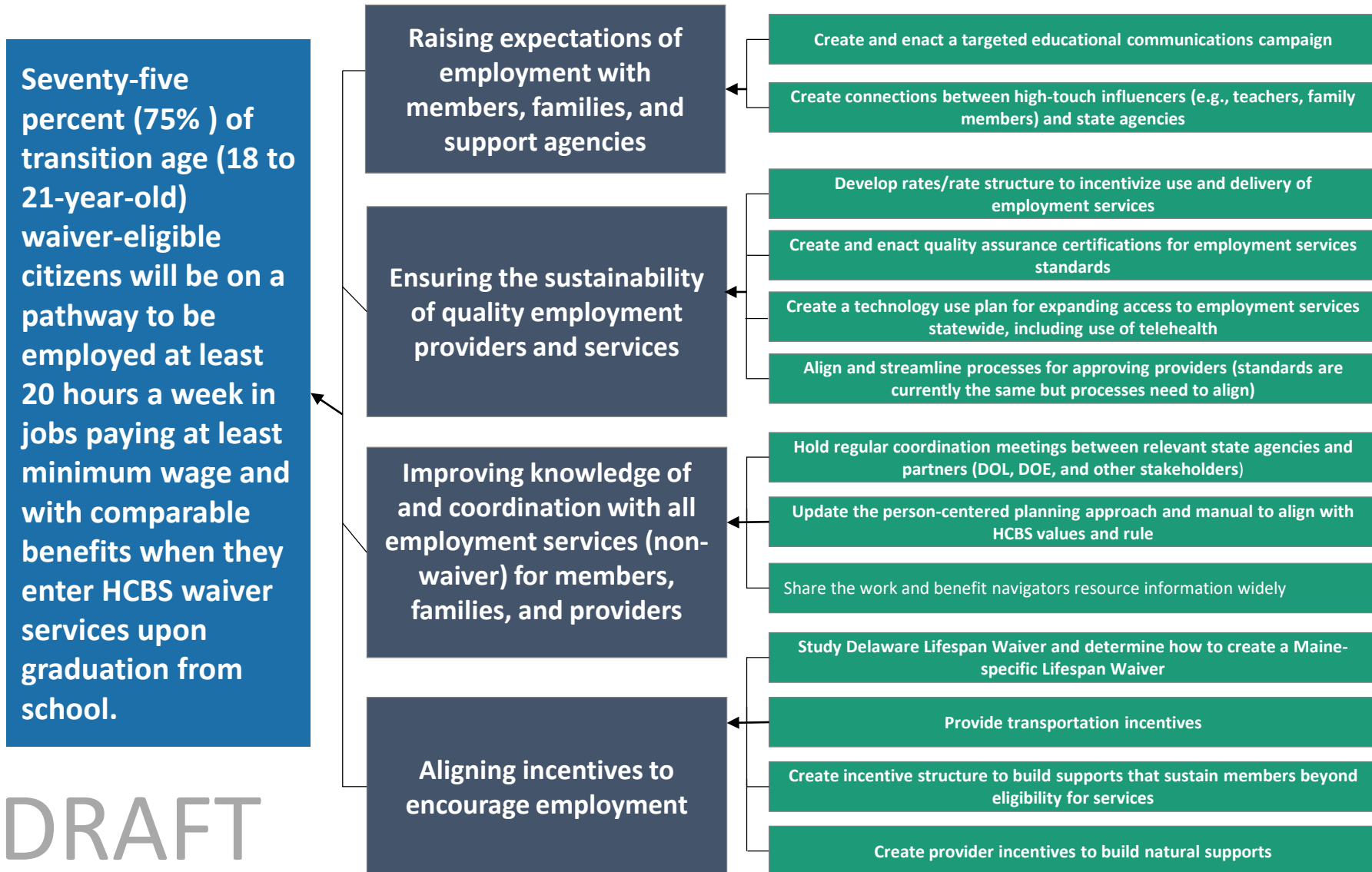
positive Recovered Deaths
